MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTION FOR OILED PARQUET

MAINTENANCE

For regular cleaning of your wooden floor please vacuum clean only. For damp cleaning of the floor you should only use warm water, a cotton towel and Clean & Polish from Naturhaus. You must not use a micro fibre towel, because it contains abrasives.

Always use two buckets: Fill one bucket with clear warm water, and the second bucket with 5 litres of warm water and 0.3 litres of Clean & Polish. Dip the cotton towel in bucket number two, squeeze it and then start cleaning the floor by moving the towel in circles. Dip the towel into bucket number one and wash it out. Now dip it again in bucket number two, squeeze it and restart cleaning the floor by moving the towels will grant you not spreading the dirt you picked up before.

TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR NEW WOODEN FLOOR (OILED PARQUET)

- Protect your floor by using a "sluice for water and mud" (water & soil resisting floor carpet) at the entrance.
- Avoid standing water (e.g. leaking vase or flower pots)
- Vacuum clean regularly.
- Equip your movables with suitable sliding aids (e.g. felt).
- Floor coverings like rubber or latex might cause spots on your parquet.
- Do not use acrid, highly alkaline or solvent solutions, it might damage or disintegrate the surface.
- Provide a balanced atmospheric humidity of about 45 until 55%.
